REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Alzheimer Society of Thunder Bay is initiating a Local Research Grant to encourage new researchers in the Thunder Bay area to investigate both the individual and the social issues relating to Alzheimer's disease and related dementias.

The Society is interested in research studies which aim to inform and thus to enhance the quality of life for those living with this disease and/or their caregivers.

A grant of \$1,000 will be awarded to support research for a graduate thesis (or major paper), pilot research projects contributing to further study, and/or travel expenses to disseminate research findings relative to dementia studies. Awards are made for a one year period.

Proposals are requested from researchers in the social science disciplines who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Senior undergraduate or graduate student supervised by a university faculty member (at any academic rank)
- New scholars who have held a tenured or tenure-track position at the university for less than five years, or who have completed their first doctorate no more than five years before the application deadline.

Deadline for submission is February 28, 2010.
